#### **Technical Description:**

The product is a non-silicone, protective coating, which provides long term protection to mould tool surfaces after use. It removes any surface moisture and protects the mould tool against corrosion during storage.

It comes in two types. A coloured type, and a clear wax type.

The coloured variant incorporates a highly visible tracer dye for easy visual identification, ensuring complete coverate and thus total protection.

The clear wax variant is non-staining and highly recommended for use with white or clear polymers.

Both types have a viscous consistency which prevents "run-off" and inhibits creeping into the mould tool.

The film resists the effect of high humidity. It will not harden or crack and is easily moulded off when recommencing production.

Alternatively it may be removed with any of the products in the Mouldpro Mould Cleaning section.

#### **Application:**

From a 25–30 cm distance (9"–12") apply a light, even coating to all surfaces. Ensure that the surfaces have cooled below 35°C to ensure optimum film formation.
